

Telangana varsities shine in NIRF 2025 rankings

UNIVERSITY OF HYDERABAD, IITH, NALSAR AND OSMANIA UNIVERSITY LEAD THE CHARGE

TELANGANA'S higher education institutions have made a strong mark in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, with the University of Hyderabad (UoH), Osmania University, and NALSAR University of Law securing prominent positions across multiple categories.

UoH emerged as the state's

top performer, ranking 18th in the University category, 26th overall, 32nd among Research Institutions, and 70th in Engineering. The university's consistent focus on research, innovation, and inclusivity has helped it maintain its national stature. Vice Chancellor Prof. B J Rao expressed pride in the achievement, while acknowledging the need for continued improvement in a competitive academic landscape.

Osmania University, one of the oldest institutions in the region, ranked 7th among State Public Universities, reinforcing its legacy as a center of academic excellence. The university's performance reflects its sustained efforts in teaching, outreach, and infrastructure development.

In the legal education domain, NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad, secured the 3rd rank nationally, placing it among the top law schools in India. Known

for its rigorous curriculum and thought leadership in legal studies, NALSAR continues to attract top talent from across the country.

Other Telangana institutions also made notable appearances. The National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPER), Hyderabad, ranked 5th in the Pharmacy category, highlighting the state's growing prominence in pharmaceutical research and education.

Additionally, the Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad (IIT-H) secured the 7th position in Engineering, further cementing its reputation as a hub for cutting-edge technology and innovation.

The NIRF rankings, released by the Ministry of Education, assess institutions based on parameters such as Teaching, Learning and Resources, Research and Professional Practice, Graduation Outcomes, Outreach and



Inclusivity, and Perception. With over 23% more institutions participating this year, the com-

petition has intensified, making Telangana's performance all the more commendable.

UoH secures top spots, reaffirms key role in higher education

THE University of Hyderabad (UoH) has once again demonstrated its academic



strength and research excellence

by securing top positions in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, released by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

UoH has been ranked 18th in the University category, 26th overall, 32nd among Research Institutions, and 70th in the Engineering category, reaffirming its position as one of India's leading centers for higher education and interdisciplinary research.

The NIRF rankings evaluate institutions across five key parameters: Teaching, Learning and Resources (TLR), Research and Professional Practice (RP), Graduation Outcome (GO), Outreach and Inclusivity (OI), and Perception (PR). These metrics collectively determine the overall score and national standing of each institution.

Reacting to the rankings, UoH Vice Chancellor Prof. B J Rao expressed both pride and determination. "I'm happy to see the University of Hyderabad's commitment to academic excellence reflected in the NIRF 2025 rankings. However, we need to do much better," he said. Prof. Rao emphasized the university's ongoing efforts to foster a culture of innovation, research, and inclusivity, and congratulated faculty, students, and staff for their dedication.

OU rises in NIRF 2025 rankings on back of strong research

OSMANIA University (OU) has made significant strides in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, climbing to 53rd in the Overall category, up from 70th in 2024.

In the University category, OU advanced from 43rd to 30th, reflecting its growing academic reputation. While its rank among State Public Universities shifted slightly from 6th to 7th, the overall trajectory remains upward. Vice-Chancellor Prof. Kumar Molugaram credited the improvement to a strategic emphasis on research. "This progress is a testament to the hard work of our faculty," he said. OU's total research citations surged from 15,000 to 90,000, and its H-index rose to 121, driven by enhanced visibility on platforms like Google Scholar and Vidwan.

PJTAU climbs to 24th rank in NIRF 2025, V-C credits govt support, staff's efforts

PROFESSOR Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University (PJTAU) has made a remarkable leap in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, securing the 24th position among agricultural and agriculture-affiliated universities and institutions across India. The ranking, released today by the Ministry of Education, marks a 13-rank improvement from last year's 37th position.

Vice-Chancellor Prof. Aldas Janaiah expressed pride in the university's achievement, noting that PJTAU now ranks 4th among agricultural institutions

in South India. He attributed the progress to focused initiatives undertaken since he assumed office 10 months ago, along with strong government support and the dedicated efforts of faculty, staff, and students.

Prof. Janaiah highlighted the establishment of four modern research centers as a key driver of the university's improved performance. These include the Center for Digital Agriculture, aimed at integrating advanced technologies into farming; the Center for Natural Resources and Environment, focusing

on conservation research; the Center for Sustainable Agricultural Systems; and the Center for Human Resource Development, which enhances the capabilities of teaching and non-teaching staff.

JNTUH secures 94th rank in NIRF 2025 Engg category

JAWAHARLAL Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH) has achieved the 94th rank nationally in the Engineering category of the NIRF 2025 rankings. Within Telangana, JNTUH stands in 6th place, marking a significant recognition for the institution.

JNTUH is the only State-Funded Technological University from Telangana to participate in the NIRF Ranking Process. All other universities from the state featured in the Engineering category are either private or Centrally Funded institutions.
